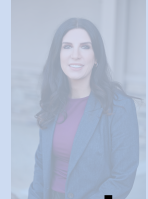

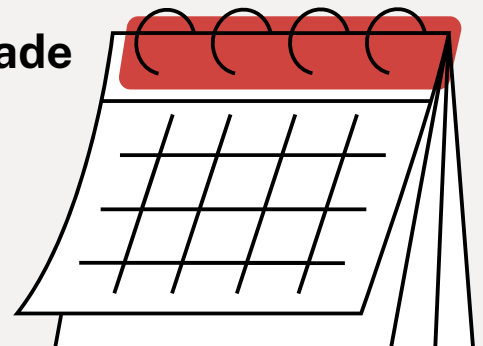

1st Grade: 8:30 to 9:00 a.m.

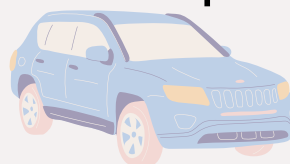
2nd Grade: 9:00 to 9:30 a.m.
